Formal Uniform

- Navy cardigan with crest
- White dress shirt, short or long sleeve
- Clip-on tie
- Grey dress pants with black leather belt and grey socks
- Black leather shoes, with velcro closing if the student cannot tie their shoes themselves with **non-marking soles**

GRADE K – 3 GIRLS

Formal Uniform

- Navy cardigan with crest
- White dress shirt, short or long sleeve
- Bow tie
- Tunic with navy knee socks or navy tights
- Grey pants with black leather belt and grey socks (Optional)
- Black leather shoes with velcro closing, with if the student can't tie the shoes themselves and **non-marking sole**
