



## Grade Nine to Twelve School Supply List 2008/2009

- 2 Soft pencil case (preferably 3-hole punched)
- 13 Fine-tipped felt pens
- 1 Package coloured pencils
- 12 HB Pencils 4 x 4 H pencils
- 2 Faber erasers
- 1 Plastic metric ruler (15 cm; mm and cm markings)
- 10 2" hard binders (solid colours: red, yellow, blue, black, and green) or binder(s) that will hold up to 10 subjects
- 2 Glue sticks (21-35g)
- 3 Medium blue pens
- 4 Package index dividers (5's)
- 1 Seven-piece Geometry set (must have ruler, protractor and compass)
- 2 Red pens
- 1 Pair of scissors (sharp)
- 1 French/English Dictionary
- 1 Spanish Dictionary (Grades 7-9)
- 4 Packages lined loose leaf paper
- 1 Scientific Calculator with memory
- 9 Computer disks (Grades 8-12)
- 1 Package graph paper
