



Grade Seven and Eight School Supply List 2008/2009

- 1 Shelf for locker
- 1 USB Drive (128 MB is sufficient)
- 1 Soft pencil case (preferably 3-hole punched)
- 12 Fine-tipped felt pens
- 1 Package coloured pencils
- 12 HB Pencils 4 x 4H pencils
- 2 Erasers (white)
- 1 Plastic metric ruler (15 cm; mm and cm markings)
- 10 1 ½" hard binders labeled by subject area
- 4 Glue sticks (21-35g)
- 3 Pens (Blue or Black is fine)
- 4 Packages index dividers (5's)
- 1 Seven-piece Geometry set (must have ruler, protractor and compass)
- 2 Red pens
- 1 Pair of scissors (sharp)
- 1 French/English Dictionary
- 1 Spanish Dictionary (Grades 7-9)
- 4 Packages lined loose leaf paper – 2 to keep in the cubbies – 2 to the teacher -to be handed to students during the year.
- 1 calculator
- 1 Package graph paper
- 1 English Thesaurus
- 2 Boxes of Kleenex
- 1 Bescherelle (10-12) (Blue in Colour) (Verb conjugation book)
- 2 Sharpie black markers – one thin-tipped, one medium-tipped
- 1 Box clear tape, reg. width – 18mm x 33m – any brand is OK.
- 1 Package plain copy paper 8 1/2 x 11

Note: Grade 7 – Students must have a dedicated binder (1 1/2" size) for GH 7 with five dividers in it. English 7 will also need 1 – 3" binder with 1 divider for "Wordly Wise"; 1 divider for creative writing and 1 divider for Grammar. Also, students need one duo tang for Literary Journals.

NB: New students who are taking Spanish and/or French will require a copy of Spanish, The Easy Way and French, The Easy Way (Black soft-cover book – Barron's Publisher) available at Chapters or Coles Bookstore. Please order early!

Please note: All supplies **must be labeled** with your child's name or initials and brought to school on the first day. The teacher will distribute them as required throughout the year. Unused supplies will be returned at the end of the school year.
