



Glenfir School Bus Rules

Student behavior while riding the bus is to reflect the same expectation as do all school behavior rules. It is imperative that all students exhibit safe conduct. Any behavior that **distracts the driver** is a hazard to everyone.

- Students must wear their school uniforms with pride and respect.
- Students must be respectful of each other.
- Students must be seated while the bus is moving.
- Students must not use inappropriate language on the bus.
- Students must keep the aisle way clear of bags or any other obstacles.
- Students must keep arms or head inside a moving bus.
- No objects should be thrown from the bus.
- No waste or objects should be thrown about inside of the bus.
- No loud or disruptive behavior is allowed which may distract the driver.
- No eating or drinking on the bus.

The bus ride is an extension of the school day. All rules which apply to school behavior also apply to bus behavior.

Students who are cited for infractions of school bus rules or regulations on the bus will have a conduct report filled out. The report will be signed by both the Managing Director and parent. Students breaching the school's standard of conduct will be dealt with as set out in the school discipline policy. Repeated infractions of bus conduct may result in suspension of riding privileges.
